



## PURPOSE

### Universal School Uniform

1. All students, year 3 to year 13, should wear the same school uniform in the correct manner as laid out in the current Academy brochure Edition 3. It is mandatory the catalogue is followed in view of the Oneschool brand being represented by all Focus schools.
2. Parents must obtain all uniform items from their local campus coordinator for UK and EU. The range includes all garment types including sports and accessories.
3. It is unacceptable for schools to substitute items from the Academy Schoolwear range or purchase garments from any other supplier other than their local campus.
4. All new products available from the coordinators will be on brand from August 2015. It will take till early 2016 before every product is available. For information and updates please contact your local coordinator.

Focus assume that any parent enrolling their student have made the choice to follow all policies. Therefore the uniform will be adhered to and worn with pride as part of the Oneschool global brand.

### **Footwear**

Shoes are to be regular plain black leather school shoes. Lace-ups, velcro straps and buckles are acceptable so long as they are 'school shoes'. Suede shoes, boots, joggers, trainers, sand shoes and leisure shoes are not acceptable.

### **Garment Range**

School uniforms should be clean and presentable. Torn or badly damaged garments that cannot be mended should be promptly replaced. All items of clothing (especially outer wear) should be labelled with the student's name.

### **Skirt Length**

The specified length of each of the girls' lower garments are as follows:

Summer Dress – 10-15 cm below the knee mid point

Winter Dress – 10-15 cm below the knee mid point

Sports Skirt – Maximum length is the knee mid point

### **Socks and Tights**

- Summer – Girls: white ankle socks, Boys: black socks
- Winter – Girls: black microfibre tights, Boys black socks

- Sports – Girls: white ankle socks, Boys: short white socks

### **Tokens and Headcoverings**

Hats (by end 2015) should be worn by girls:

- For School excursions

The following list will provide a guide for what is acceptable for wearing with this school uniform:

- Navy or Burgundy Headbands
- Navy or Burgundy Bows
- Navy or Burgundy Ribbons
- Navy or burgundy scrunchies

These are the only items acceptable for wearing as tokens. Feathers, flowers and other large items are not appropriate for wearing as tokens at school.

### **Neck Scarves**

A Navy and Burgundy neck scarf is offered in the Academy range (No alternatives)

Cambridge Campus expects pupils to wear the summer uniform in the Summer Term and first half of the Autumn Term, unless specifically instructed otherwise. Sep 17 update - There are 124 pupils. 35 primary (21 boys, 14 girls) and 89 secondary pupils (39 boys, 50 girls). There are 2 pupils with EHCP plans. The catchment area is mainly Cambridge, Thaxted and Stamford. Most pupils travel by buses provided by the school.
